Worcester Community Fridges is a community run operation that partners with farms, grocers, and local restaurants to rescue food that would otherwise be thrown away. Individuals may also drop off food, within their food guidelines, 24/7 at any community fridge. They accept and offer all produce, unopened frozen meals, pantry staples, packaged and labeled

dairy products, and packaged factory sealed deli meats. They will not accept raw meat, homemade meals, previously opened foods, or expired or moldy foods.

Locations: Fantastic Pizza (910 Main St, Worcester MA), The Printer Building (44 Portland St, Worcester MA), Massachusetts League of Community Health Centers (16 Brooks St, Worcester MA), and Union Hill School (42 South Street, Worcester MA).
